Work Experience Visits



The My Child At School app will now accept Google Pay and Apple Pay. There is no additional charge to use these services.

You will first need to have an existing account with your chosen provider (either Google Pay or Apple Pay) and have a payment method linked to your account. Then in MCAS add all required items to your basket, select Checkout, and in the Payment Options section, select either Google Pay or Apple Pay.

Pupils are due back in school on Wednesday 3rd September 2025.




Lunch Menu


